Who Are We?

We are male and female victims of sexual abuse, molestation and misconduct by clergy (priests, nuns and pastors), employees, teachers, and volunteers in the Catholic Church and other religious groups.

Why Are We Here?

Four alleged child molesters lived and worked here at Our Lady of Guadalupe:

Paul Gill	1967-1971
Paulino Montagne	1974
Edward Rodrigue	1968-1971
Barry Vinvard	1978-1981 and 1987-1991

We hope that if there are victims here suffering in shame and silence, they'll know that they are not alone and we can help them get help and healing.

What Do We Want?

We want to prevent more abuse and help survivors by telling parishioners about accused and admitted molesters who have had access to children in their parish.

What Can You Do?

3) Call Bishop Robert Brom (858) 490-8200 and demand that he turn over ALL personnel files and sealed settlement records of alleged molesters to prosecutors and civil authorities and stop "dumping" alleged molesters in parishes where they may molest more innocent children
